### 2026-2027 NATIONAL BUDGET

### CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Ministry of Finance invites individuals, businesses, civil society organisations and community groups to share their views as preparation begins for the 2026-2027 National Budget.

The 2026-2027 Budget will focus on the Government's vision of rebuilding a better Fiji together. The Budget will pursue strategies to safeguard macro-fiscal stability by promoting sustainable and resilient private sector led growth, addressing socio-economic challenges, nurturing inclusive development and building economic and fiscal safeguards to respond to future shocks. Additionally, the Budget will prioritise key infrastructure needs, building climate resilience, accelerating structural reforms and enhancing efficiency in public service delivery. The 2026-2027 Budget will be announced in June 2026.

Public participation is essential in shaping policies that will contribute to a more inclusive and prosperous future for Fiji. Members of the public are encouraged to provide written submissions for consideration. Written submissions can either be posted, hand-delivered or e-mailed by no later than **Thursday, 30 April 2026** to the following addresses:
