



YOUR GOVERNMENT WANTS TO HEAR FROM YOU 2021-2022 NATIONAL BUDGET CONSULTATIONS

The Ministry of Economy has commenced preparations for the 2021-2022 National Budget and is calling all Fijians to provide their views and ideas for the upcoming Budget.

The impacts of the global economic crisis brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic have been devastating for the Fijian economy. The upcoming National Budget will form a key pillar of a robust economic recovery that puts Fijians back to work and revives critical industries, like tourism.

The Ministry of Economy invites all Fijians, including civil society and non-governmental organisations, women, youth, senior citizens, Fijians living with disabilities, other grassroots organisations and representative from the private sector to participate in this year's consultation and voice their views and opinions on the 2021-2022 National Budget.

Following our first online budget consultation on 28 February 2021, Fijians can now make written submissions which can be posted, hand delivered or e-mailed by 14 May 2021 to the following addresses:
