#### **The following documents MUST be submitted with a completed application form:**

- Copies of the Identification Cards of group members (Voter ID preferred)
- Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) Letter or latest Joint FNPF/FRCS Card
- Copy of Group Registration Certificate or Letter / Deed Trust / Registered FBO approval
- Letter of Approval for use of Land
- FNPF membership numbers for eligible members (55 and below)

The completed online applications will be generated from the online portal and there is no need to physically deliver these applications.
