The Ministry of Finance, Strategic Planning, National Development and Statistics is once again calling on individuals, businesses and community groups to make their voices heard as preparation begins for the 2025-2026 National Budget.

The 2025-2026 Budget will focus on the Government's vision of rebuilding a better Fiji together. The Budget will pursue strategies to safeguard macro-fiscal stability by promoting sustainable and resilient private sector led growth, addressing socio-economic challenges, nurturing inclusive development, and building economic and fiscal safeguards to respond to future shocks. Additionally, the Budget will prioritise key infrastructure needs, building climate resilience, accelerating structural reforms and enhancing efficiency in public service delivery. The 2025-2026 Budget will be announced in June 2025.
