2026 Back to School Support Application Form

The Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Education are rolling out the Back-to-School Support of \$200 per child for all Early Childhood Education to Year 13 students for the school year 2026. The assistance is available to parents/guardians to purchase school-related items for their children.

- 2. Parents/guardians are to fill in one application form per child.

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Instructions for applying the Back-to-School Support

Overview of the initiative

- The Back-to-School Support of \$200 per student (early childhood education to year 13) aims to financially assist parents and guardians to prepare their children for the new school year 2026.
- Parents and guardians need to fill in the manual form and submit all the required documents and statutory declaration form to their child's school before application period ends.
- Parents/Guardians are to fill in one application form per child.

Application and Payment dates

- The Back-to-School support application will open on 11 November 2025 and will close on 12 December 2025.
- If applications are not received and submitted within the specified deadline, the student will not be eligible to receive the \$200 support.
- The expected payment will be made on 16 January 2026.
- Parents/Guardians are to ensure they provide the correct MPAiSA/MyCash number which is valid and registered under their name.

Eligibility Criteria

- All students enrolled in early childhood education to year 13 for school year 2026 whose parents/guardians combined gross annual household income is \$50,000 or less are eligible;
- Students enrolled in both Government funded public schools and private schools are eligible;
- Combined household income is the gross income of both the parents/guardians;
- Gross income for the sake of determining eligibility for the Back-to-School Support will include any
 parental/guardian income from employment, income from property and income from
 business/investments before any tax deductions are made.

Documents required

Parents/guardians are required to attach all required documents to confirm their eligibility. Failure to submit the necessary documentation will result in the application for the Back-to-School support being declined.

The following documentation must be provided to support the application:

- Salary slips and/or employment contracts of working parents/guardians; and/or
- Other documentation such as evidence of social welfare payments or transport assistance; and/or
- A statutory declaration will be required for applicants whose parents/guardians do not have any other documentation to substantiate their income.
